## June 10-14 • Paper Puppet Paradise

Learn different styles of puppetry! Create paper puppets, simple marionettes, masks, and more. In this class, we will invent, design, build, and bring to life puppet characters from our imaginations.

## June 17-21 (No Camp Wed, June 19)

### Adventures in Painting & Drawing

From whimsical watercolors to adventures in drawing, we will play with expressive painting, drawing, and mixed media. We'll explore materials, techniques, and color as well as scale, line, texture, and shape in a series of fun projects inspired by nature. We will paint on different surfaces, explore drawing from life, and dive into artful bookmaking!

## July 15-19 • Mixed Media Madness

Explore color, shape, pattern, and texture using mixed media including paint, collage, graphite, sculpture, and more to investigate the world around you. Create mixed media work inspired by artists throughout history, including contemporary Bay Area artists.

## July 22-26

### Wearable Art: Express Yourself!

Create unique and fabulous works of art, including mixed-media wearable art that tells a story! We'll look at animals, nature, and artists as inspiration for colorful works on fabric. Express yourself through hands-on projects that incorporate block printing and monotype on fabric, embroidery, sun printing and painting on fabric, and screen printing.

## July 29-August 2 • Printmaking Magic!

Discover the joy and magic of printmaking! Using found objects such as string, fabric, leaves, legos, and bubble wrap, we will explore different ways of making marks using unconventional materials and printing surfaces.

## June 24-28

### Teen Studio: Drawing From Life

Join us for a deep dive into drawing! Explore ways that drawing can reflect individual voices, through careful observation and exploration of mark-making. Learn about line quality, form, tone, negative space, and composition while using a variety of drawing media. Projects will include linear perspective study, still life, portraits, the figure (with a live model), landscapes, and personal narrative.

## July 8-12 • Teen Studio: Acrylic Painting

Learn how to build a painting from the ground up! We will explore various styles and techniques for working with acrylic paint including underpainting and building value. Youth will experiment with brushwork, color, and paint mediums to create unique works of art on canvas and other surfaces.

## July 22-26 • Teen Studio: The Comics Lab

Journey into comic illustration! Learn how to translate words into action and create vibrant comic panels in this one-week extravaganza! We will explore writing, storyboarding, illustrating, and laying out a visual narrative from start to finish, adopt techniques seen in animation and graphic novels, and develop and gain confidence in drawing the human anatomy and perspective.

## July 29-August 2

### Teen Studio: Digital Photography

Experiment with a range of photography styles and techniques from landscapes and portraits to photomontage and collage. A series of projects will offer opportunities to learn the technical and conceptual aspects of photography. We'll cover framing and composition and spend time at Kala's digital lab for an introduction to photo editing and printing.
